

## HOW TO JOIN

This is the basic process:

1. Visit our website [www.bvifc.org](http://www.bvifc.org) to learn more about our club. From the site you can review our by-laws, operating regulations and download a membership application.
2. Contact us and discuss membership with the club president or other member to learn more and/or come to a monthly club meeting and see what we're about.
3. Complete application and obtain a FAA and DMV record check.
4. Bring application, application fee, and records check to an interview with club board members.
5. Upon notification of eligibility to join, a club checkout will be accomplished with the safety officer at which time the initiation fee is due.
6. An aircraft check ride is completed and the new member is authorized in the aircraft scheduling system.

### EXIT FLEXABILITY

The club recently revised its exit rules and no longer has an "out-list" policy requiring a replacement member.

## WHAT IT COSTS

- \$50.00 application fee. (shows us your serious)
- One time \$500 initiation fee. Money is applied towards capital assets.
- Monthly club dues of \$47.00 (2016). Required to cover the fixed costs of the club operations (e.g.: insurance, hangar rental, etc.).
- Hourly wet operating rates, updated annually, to cover cost of aircraft maintenance and fuel (2016):
  - C172 \$79.57 / hour
  - Archer \$73.66 / hour

Note: Must fly minimum 3 hours per quarter.
